### SECTION 7 – PRECAUTIONS FOR SAFE HANDLING AND USE

**Protective Gloves/Clothing:** For repeated or prolonged skin contact, the use of impervious gloves is recommended to prevent drying and possible irritation.  
**Storage:** Keep containers closed when not in use. Store in cool, dry areas.  
**In Case of Release or Spill:** Spills should be cleaned immediately using suitable absorbent (clay, sand, dirt, etc.) Mop up or wet vac. Rinse area with water to remove.  
**Waste Disposal Method:** Disposal should be made in accordance with federal, state and local regulations.

**Ventilation:** Product requires no special ventilation.  
**Eye Protection:** Wear safety glasses to protect eyes.  
**Other Precautions:** If frozen, thaw to room temperature and mix before using. Do not pour unused portion back into container - it may contaminate product.
